Chords change regularly. E.g. every bar, beat, etc	Fortepiano
Chords change with no regular pattern.	Play loudly then die away immediately
2 or more notes sung on the same syllable. I Use slur & underline.	Sforzando
A scale using all 12 notes.	Continue in a similar way.
Chord V + a 7th above the root	Fourth note of a scale = Fa
Passes between 2 chord notes a 3rd apart.	Two different names for the same note. e.g. B# & C
The naming note of a chord, the note of the scale it is built on	Amen Cadence Church Cadence
With a strong accent.	The harmony stays on the same chord
